Interesting new application. A U.S. school bus manufacturer is testing a Linear Devices Actuator, just like the standard Lectrotab trim tab actuator, with a stroke modification from 2-1/4 to 3-1/4 inches and stroke time at 2 seconds, which is how quickly it will open or close the bifold entry door. Testing is being done to confirm that the actuator will perform without maintenance for 150,000 cycles. We are past the 80,000 mark and all is well. If you run across any non-marine applications, let us know; we may be able to help.

Gotta' run now and batten down the hatches in anticipation of wind and rain from hurricane "Ivan The Terrible".
